COLUMBUS - Regulatory relief, BSA/AML compliance and banks' response to cyber threats were just some of the topics discussed at a recent national meeting of community bankers according to Jeff Johnson, President of Columbus Bank and Trust.
Johnson, who attended the meeting as a member of the American Bankers Association's Community Bankers Council May 1416 in Austin, TX, said the bankers talked about the impact of recent regulatory relief legislation and regulatory requirements on the nation's community banks and the areas they serve.
